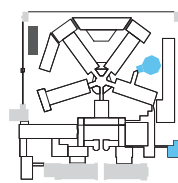
restoration : palace of justice (Organization for molested children) (5400 m2)



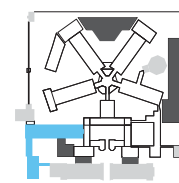
restoration : corridor park



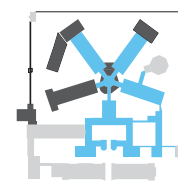
restoration : cornerhouses (former warders houses) for controlled park (300 m2), passage for corridor park (871 m2)



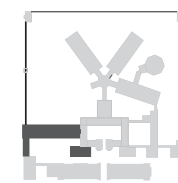
restoration : church (358 m2), kindergarten (546 m2); adaptation for shared use: library (120 m2), workspace (946 m2), basketball (425 m2)

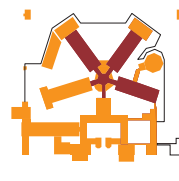
420 prisoners / 380 administrators basketball, library, first aid, church

services function as interface programme, day detention prisoners work as guards in the detention park, wing A hosts artists doing art therapy with the prisoners

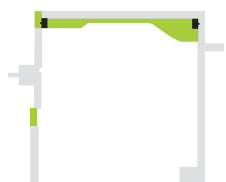

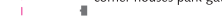
